# PREVENTION TIPS

---

Make a plan before your night out by setting up a ride share app or by using public transportation.

Select a reliable and responsible designated driver who understands the expectations, has a valid drivers license and emergency contact information on hand.

Make arrangements to stay at a hotel or somewhere near your event to avoid having to drive altogether.

If you're hosting an event, make sure to provide lots of food and water. Also be sure to cut off alcohol before the event is over to give guests plenty of time to sober up or coordinate a safe ride home.

If you think you'll be tempted to drive home while intoxicated, give your keys to a sober friend.

Never get in a car with a driver who has been drinking.

If you're out on the road and see an impaired driver, don't engage, pull over and call the police.
