AT HOME

Inspect your home frequently to ensure windows are locked, smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are properly maintained and cleaning materials and medicine are stored away.

While parked at home, always keep your car locked and remind your children they should never play in or around a car.

Keep firearms unloaded and locked away in a safe place. Talk to your children about the four steps they should take if they come into contact with a gun: **Stop, Don't Touch, Leave the Area, Tell an Adult!**

WHILE TRAVELING

Be cognizant of what information you post on your social media accounts; posting about travel plans can make your home a target for burglars.

Keep valuables out of sight and away from windows where they could be stolen.

Have a trusted neighbor keep an eye on your property, pick up your mail, and report any suspicious activity.
